What is self-directed learning?

- Self-directed learning describes a process in which a learner takes primary responsibility for planning, implementing, and evaluating his or her own learning.
- The starting point for self-directed adult learning is personal responsibility —you must acknowledge responsibility for your own thoughts and actions.

Your Adobe Acrobat Reader needs to be at least version 5.0. If it is not, complete these steps:

Troubleshooting

- Insert the HeartCode ACLS Anywhere CD into the CD drive. It will automatically bring up a welcome screen. Click Cancel.
- An install window will come up. Click Exit setup.
- Right-click on the Start button and select Explore.
- Click on the CD drive (usually a D drive).
- Click on the folder Redist.
- Click on the folder Acrobat_en. In this folder there is a file Setup.exe. Double-click this file. This will automatically install the Adobe Acrobat Reader.
- Close the window that is open. Remove CD.

You need two things to be able to get your certificate:

- <u>1</u>. The license key must have been properly activated.
- 2. You must have a green check mark in every box that appears on the righthand side of the ACLS certificate page.

HeartCode ACLS Anywhere is a computer-based self-learning system for the American Heart Association's ACLS program.

Both have 4 different parts—3 different ways to learn:



<u>HeartCode ACLS Core Cases</u>, which are real-life, real-time simulations of different acute conditions. Core Cases are presented in groups or "modules."



Team training, which provides knowledge of the fundamental concepts of team work.



<u>HeartCode ACLS Written Exam</u>, a multiple-choice exam that must be passed as part of the completion of the ACLS certificate.

What are HeartCode ACLS Anywhere simulations?

Single-user Installation

The simulations in HeartCode ACLS Anywhere work much like a computer game—you decide the pace at which you learn.

The ACLS Core Cases, the simulation-based part of HeartCode ACLS Anywhere, consists of 3 sub-parts:

 <u>The scenario selection screens</u>, from which you choose the patient scenarios within a given module. Each scenario is based on a set of learning objectives.

After you complete the training

On completion of all the core modules and the examination, print both the completion certificate for part I and the continuing education certificate.

To receive your AHA ACLS provider card, make an appointment with an AHA ACLS Training Center to complete your skills test. Take the completion certificate for part I to the Training Center where you go for your skills check. When you have successfully completed the skills, the Training Center will issue your AHA ACLS provider card.

How to use the program

After you log in the first time you need to provide information in case you lose or forget your password. After that, choose the profile most fitting to you. You are now logged in and ready to begin.

The information entered for the user will be used for the ACLS and CME/CE/CEH certification.

After you enter your activation key into the program, you have 32 hours to complete your education and certification. This is time actually spent in the program, ie, you can work 3 hours one day and then 4 hours the next day and then have 25 hours left.

The Circle of Learning is a tool that helps you understand the many aspects of learning and how they supplement each other. It may aid in planning and understanding your own learning.

There are many ways to gain knowledge—lectures, books, videos, task trainers, learning by example, simulations, and, of course, experience. The most effective way to learn is through a combination of means, plus constantly going back and forth and around in the circle.



You will eventually find the way that suits you best —we all learn in different ways.

How is the Circle of Learning relevant to me?

Single-user Installation

Assume that you decide to learn to manage a cardiac arrest:

The front inside cover of the CD plastic case will have a label that contains the License key code, as shown below. Enter the installation key as it appears (as symbols).



First, you have to acquire core knowledge (for example, through textbooks, lectures, videos, elearning, or other means).



Second, you need to acquire skills. You might use part-task trainers (eg, an IV-arm) or real-life instruction to practice and learn skills such as intubation, CPR, placing electrodes, or establishing IV-access.



How can you be sure, however, that you can actually remember and use everything you have learned?

Can you act correctly and efficiently in a real cardiac arrest?





If you receive the message "the key is illformed", this indicates that the key was typed incorrectly. Re-enter the key. Follow the prompts through the following several screens.

Instructions for prepaid ACLS license activation

- 1. Start the HeartCode ACLS Anywhere program and log on.
- 2. Click Licenses in the top menu bar.
- 3. Click Enter key.
- 4. Enter the license key as it appears on the inside cover of the CD box. Note that the dashes are not necessary; this might save you some time. Click Next.

Advanced	License overview

To assess your learning and ensure that all your knowledge and skills are perfectly tuned for the moment when it really counts, you can use a combination of micro- and macrosimulators.



Microsimulators help you practice algorithms and reinforce prior learning.



Macrosimulators and simulation allow you to train in crucial skills such as teamwork and communication.

Training with simulators will—like real-life practice—direct your attention to subject fields where you need to spend more time. This makes it easier for you to seek the specific training you need, whether it is the practice of intubation or just re-reading a certain chapter.

Consider what kind of learning you need and where in the Circle of Learning you need to focus your attention now.

Self-direct your own learning process!

Single-user Installation

Simulation can never totally replace other types of learning. It can, however, supplement, reinforce, and facilitate the more traditional types of learning—thereby boosting the learning process and helping optimize the time and effort spent.

Installation

- 1. Insert the installation CD.
- If the installation does not start automatically, click the Windows Start button and choose *Run*. Then choose *Browse* and open the CD-ROM drive. Open the Setup.exe file.
- 3. The program will tell you to close all other programs you have running before proceeding. Close any program other than the installation program and click *Next*.
- 4. The program will ask you if you agree to the License Agreement. You must agree to install and use the program.
- 5. Choose where to install the program. In most circumstances you can leave this as default. Click *Next*.
- 6. HeartCode ACLS requires Adobe Reader and Flash Player 8 to run. You will be prompted to install these programs if they are not present on your computer.
- 7. The installation will start. It may take a few minutes.
- 8. After the installation you can choose to start the program right away or you can uncheck *Start HeartCode ACLS Inhospital*. Click *Finished*.
- 9. The program has been installed.

Things to know before starting

You will need a license to use the program, which can be obtained in 3 ways, depending on your version of the program:

- Prepaid: There is a license key inside the cover of the CD box. This key must be
 entered in the program under Licenses. You must be connected to the Internet for this
 step!
- <u>Network</u>: The program will look for a license server and obtain a license for you. This happens when you are in a networked system.
- <u>Online purchase</u>: If you do not have a license you can click a link "Click here to buy" to purchase.
